## Summer Adventure in Michigan

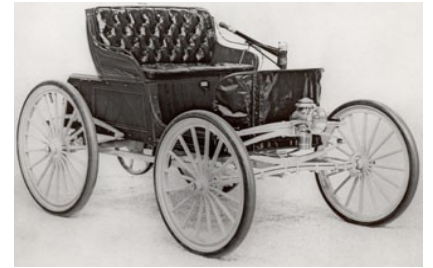
### Day 1
