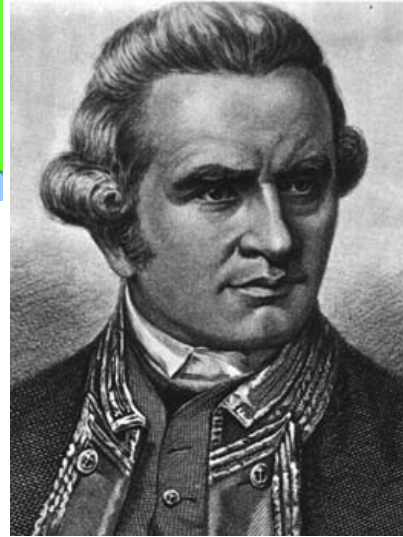


# The History of Hawaii
