

Conversation I Final Project: Recipes

A recipe tells you how to make food. In this project, you will practice writing a recipe.

- 1) Choose a dish from your country, Hawaii, or somewhere else.
- 2) Write a recipe for the dish. Include the kind of dish (appetizer, entrée, salad, dessert, beverage, etc.), a list of ingredients, and directions.
- 3) Describe how it tastes.

Example:

Entrée: Betsy's Baked Spaghetti

Ingredients:

- ½ pound of dry spaghetti
- 1 can of spaghetti sauce
- 1 can of diced tomatoes
- 1 can of sliced mushrooms
- 1 clove of garlic
- 1 teaspoon of butter
- 4 chicken breasts
- 4 slices of provolone cheese
- crushed red pepper



Directions:



- 1) Boil the spaghetti. Stop it before it is fully cooked. Drain the water. Put the spaghetti into a large glass dish.



- 2) Cook the chicken breasts in the microwave. Put them on top of the spaghetti.

- 3) Slice the garlic, and fry it with the butter. Mix the garlic, spaghetti sauce, tomatoes, and mushrooms. Put everything on top of the spaghetti and chicken.



- 4) Bake everything for 45 minutes at 350°F. Put the cheese on top and bake for another 10 minutes. Add as much crushed red pepper as you like, and enjoy!

Taste:

This dish looks and tastes delicious. It is a little bit salty and very filling. The cheese is creamy. If you add red pepper, it tastes spicy. This is my favorite spaghetti dish!
