

# International Travel Jeopardy

Draw Jeopardy board on chalkboard. Divide class into 4 teams. Teams work together to answer. Team that won last round picks question. Distribute questions to teams face down. Teams turn over questions at same time. As they do so, read the question about loud. Teams write the answers on the question papers and put the paper on the big desk when finished. The quickest team gets the first chance at the money. The team with the most money at the end wins a prize!

Final Jeopardy: Each team wagers up to the amount of money they have and work together to write the answer.
