

Subway Field Trip Homework

Due Monday, March 5.

Write one page about our field trip. You can write whatever you want. Don't forget to include a title! Here are some suggested questions to answer:

- When and where did we go? (use "on", "to", "at", etc.)
- What did you order?
- What bread/cheese/vegetables/dressings did you choose? Why?
- What vegetables did you NOT choose? Why?

- Did you like your meal? If not, what was wrong?

- Was ordering difficult? What part was difficult? Why?

A Tasty Sandwich at Subway
