

Vocabulary Logs

Every week, you will choose **five new words**. These words can come from class, things you read, etc. They do not have to be directly related to travel, but your example sentences must be. Write or type them in your vocabulary log. It is due every Tuesday, starting on January 30. You can hand them to me or send them by email (Word file).

For each word, write

- a) The word.
- b) Its function, e.g., noun (count or non-count), verb, adjective, adverb, preposition.
- c) Its meaning. You can use your dictionary, but try to write the meaning in your own words.
- d) One (travel-related) sentence using the word. Underline the word.

Example:

- 1) a) flight
b) count noun
c) a trip on an airplane
d) My flight from Tokyo to Honolulu took eight hours.
- 2) a) sincere
b) adjective
c) truthful, with real feeling
d) A sincere smile helps customers feel welcome.
- 3) a) nationality
b) count noun
c) belonging to a nation
d) Betsy asked for my nationality, so I told her that I am Japanese.

You will have a short vocabulary quiz each Monday, starting April 16. Each quiz will have two parts: new and old words. You will be graded on the old words only. That means that you get a chance to see the new words on a quiz before you are graded on them. The quiz words may come from your vocabulary journals or from class.
